Ai Weiwei, Rebar in Gold (2013), Elisabetta Cipriani, from \$34,000



Big spenders may take a shine to Al Weiwels "wearable collection from \$34,000 and the Condon gallery Elisabetta Clyraini (In Banara).

Al Weiwels "wearable sculptures" at Elisabetta Clyraini (until 16 january). The ridged lengths of gold, priced between \$34,000 and spenders but can be twisted by the wearar to fit around a dinger, wrist or neck. bubbed Rebar in Gold, the collection is reminiscent of Ar's monumental installation Straight (2008-12). The artists studio straightened 90 ionnes of mangled steel reinforcing bars from Chinese scraparacts for awar attention to the 2008 earthquake in the Sichana province, where shoddy construction contributed to the deaths of more than 5,000 school children.
